



YOUR PCS OPTIONS



THERE ARE THREE WAYS TO EXECUTE A PCS MOVE

1

A Government Contract Move - Your local TMO will verify your orders and contract a commercial moving company to pack, ship and unpack your belongings.

2

A PPM/DITY Move - Allows you to pack, ship and unpack your own belongings. The government pays you 95% of what it would cost them to contract a commercial mover plus standard travel allowances for you and your family. If you end up spending less than the 95% payment the government provides, you get to keep the rest.

- *Want to maintain control of your move but not have to move it yourself? With a PPM Move, you still have the option to hire a partial or full-service mover to help you out - just make sure you estimate your allowance beforehand and stay under that total amount. Finding companies that offer discounts on packing supplies and military discounts will help!*

3

A Combination Move - Part of your goods are moved by the government and you move the remainder. The government imposes a weight restriction on PCS moves based on rank and dependents, and will not pay for any weight moved by you above that restriction.
